WHAT WE KNOW FOR SURE: The reunion will run from Wednesday, 1 Oct 08, thru Sunday, 5 Oct 08. Headquarters will be the Embassy Suites Hotel on the north side of Colorado Springs with quick access to the Academy. The AOG will handle all the registration and administrative details for the class.

TENTATIVE PLAN FOR KEY EVENTS:

Wed: 1) registration at the Embassy Suites - 1600-2000 2) class social in early evening with hors-de-oeuvres provided by the class, no-host bar 3) dinner on your own (many restaurants in the vicinity within an easy walk)

Thurs: 1) registration all day at the Embassy Suites - 0730-1200, 1400-2000 2) spirit walk at the Academy in the morning 3) lunch with cadets in Mitchell Hall 4) individual activities in Colorado Springs in the afternoon (group activities possible, see our class website) 5) class social and dinner at the Embassy Suites (casual dress)

Friday: 1) golf 2) late registration all day at Doolittle Hall (AOG building) – 0800 – 1730 3) lunch at the Academy 4) Academy open house and presentations by Senior Staff with question time 5) Memorial Service 6) class social and dinner at the Embassy Suites, including a special presentation by the Cadet Chorale (coat and tie recommended)

Saturday: 1) pre game tailgate at the Falcon Stadium 2) beat Navy 3) post-game victory celebration at the stadium 4) dinner on your own in the local area (squadron activities recommended)

Sunday: no planned class activities, departure at your leisure
